Henderson Health Care is strengthening our commitment to women's health with the acquisition of a new mammography machine, the Fujifilm ASPIRE Cristalle. This investment enhances early detection and diagnosis of breast cancer, providing patients with advanced, life-saving technology close to home.

The new system increases our ability to detect breast abnormalities with greater precision and accuracy. Its stereotactic biopsy functionality allows providers to perform minimally invasive procedures using 3D imaging guidance, leading to earlier diagnosis, faster results, and improved patient comfort.

"The addition of this advanced mammography system with stereotactic biopsy capabilities represents a significant step forward for our patients. It allows us to provide earlier, more accurate diagnoses while reducing the need for patients to travel elsewhere for specialized care. We're proud to expand access to this level of technology right here in our rural community," said Radiology Supervisor, Brenda Jennelle. "It reflects our dedication to early detection, which is one of the most powerful tools in the fight against breast cancer."

By expanding mammography and biopsy services, Henderson Health Care aims to reduce wait times for patients, improve convenience, and further strengthen our role as a trusted healthcare partner in the region. Appointments for mammograms are available every week day and we encourage women over 40—or those with risk factors—to schedule their screenings by calling our radiology department at (402) 723-4002.

Complete with 12 exam rooms, 2 procedure suites, on-site laboratory and diagnostic services, this clinic aims to enhance both the patient experience and work flow for our clinical teams.



A recent milestone includes moving into vertical construction. With the footings and pad now poured, crews are now moving upward with the structure. The most visible progress—walls, framing, and roofing—will begin taking shape soon. Sampson Construction and subcontractors are working diligently to maintain timelines while ensuring the highest standards of safety and quality.

As we remain on track, anticipation builds for the clinic's opening, which is expected to take place in the Summer of 2026. We look forward to welcoming patients into this new space and continuing to provide the compassionate, high-quality care our communities desire.

HHC Welcomes AMI Interventional Radiology Group

We are pleased to announce the addition of a new Interventional Radiology (IR) group to our medical team. This partnership brings expanded access to advanced, minimally invasive procedures that offer patients effective treatment options with less pain, shorter recovery times, and improved outcomes.

Interventional Radiology uses imaging technologies—such as ultrasound and CT—to guide targeted treatments through small incisions. This specialty can address a wide range of conditions, including vascular disease, cancer therapies, pain management, biopsies, and emergency interventions. By adding this service, we are able to provide more comprehensive care close to home.

"We are excited to welcome Advanced Medical Imaging's Interventional Radiology Group to our community," said HHC CEO, Cheryl Brown. "The availability of IR services means that patients no longer need to travel long distances for advanced care. From performing targeted biopsies and opening blocked blood vessels to stopping internal bleeding and treating certain cancers, interventional radiology provides lifesaving and life-improving options right in our rural community."

The team of Dr. Quinton Kelly, Dr. Rahul Razdan, and Dr. Eric Vander Woude, will begin seeing patients in Henderson in October. Patients can be referred by their primary care provider or specialist, and in some cases may self-refer for consultation.
